

Pa80 Update Instructions

When updating the Pa80 one must start by upgrading the operating system (o.s) first. Download the o.s. and the resource data from <http://www.korgpa80.com> first. This is available for both PC and Mac platforms.

PC Instructions:

Wherever you chose to save the downloaded o.s.file, go to it on your computer and simply double click on the .exe file. This .exe program will format and create a disk for you. **DO NOT drag and drop the .exe file or you the update will be unsuccessful!** Go to the Pa80, put this disk you just made in and turn on the Pa80. The Pa80 will see the disk and know it is an o.s disk; you will be prompted on the screen to do an o.s update, follow the instructions.

Mac Instructions:

Alt-click, save Object...Prepare 6 HD DOS formatted empty disks. Drag and Drop the '.sit' files over the Stuff It (Ver.5.5 or higher) application's icon. Then copy the **contents** of the generated folders to Floppy disk, not the folders.

Resource Data:

The other 5 disks are resource data. Download these files and use the same Instructions as above for whichever platform. Now you have 5 disks in hand with the backup data (resource data).

Now that you have successfully updated the Pa80's o.s. as per instructions above, the Pa80's screen is now prompting you to remove the o.s. disk and press any key. Please do so, and please do not ask where the any key is!!! The Pa80 has now rebooted. Go to disk mode, utilities, restore data. Insert the first disk and press enter. The Pa80 will prompt you for the other disks.

Possible problems/solution:

Try formatting the disks on the Pa80 first then repeat the process for whichever platform (Mac or PC).

Make sure to use High Density disk (HD).
